Tomato List 2024

Determinate: "Bush" varieties that reach a certain height and then stop growing, with most fruit borne over a 4–6-week period. Excellent for a concentrated harvest. These plants can grow without support or with short stakes or cages. Perfect for a patio, container, or small gardens.

Indeterminate: Pole or stake varieties that continue to grow and flower throughout the season but have less mature fruits at any one time. Often will continue to grow until frost, with harvest lasting several months. These plants require tall stakes, cages, or trellises.

Abraham Lincoln

 HEIRLOOM/ PASTE. (87 days; Indeterminate) Beautiful dark red fruits, sweet, meaty solid. Fruits are smooth, free from cracks and seams and ripen all the way through. Ideal for ketchup, juice, or slicing. Sturdy plants.

Alice's Dream
